RE: BURNABY COMMUNITY STANDARDS COMMITTEE

Madam and Gentlemen:

On 1984 May 07, Council adopted the following motions:

1. THAT Council establish a Burnaby Community Standards Committee that is representative of all sectors of the community, i.e. School Board; voluntary organizations; R.C.M.P.; Justice organizations; parent groups; church groups; labour; Chamber of Commerce; health groups; and/or any groups interested and deemed appropriate.
2. THAT Council establish a Community Standards Committee for the purpose of (i) defining community standards in Burnaby, and (ii) to facilitate public education and awareness about community standards.
3. THAT this be an ongoing committee of Burnaby Council."

At that time, and again at the 1984 December 03 Inaugural Meeting, Alderman Rankin was appointed Chairman of the Burnaby Community Standards Committee with Aldermen Lawson and Nikolai as members.

It was also understood at the 1984 May 07 Council Meeting that the Burnaby Community Standards Committee would be comprised of seven members with the newly appointed three (3) members to select and recommend to Council the names of the proposed four (4) additional members.
