29. B. C. Women's Water Polo Team

A request has been received from Mrs. Agnes O'Connell for a grant in an unspecified amount. The purpose of this request is to assist with travel expenses to attend the National Finals in Quebec City in 1985 May. The team consists of young women between the ages of 14 and 19 years and 1/3 of the team comes from Burnaby (4 out of 12).

The women attended the Western Play-downs in Edmonton and placed 2nd in Western Canada. This placing entitles the team to attend the National Finals in Quebec City in May.

Your Committee would recommend that \$333.33 be awarded to the B. C. Women's Water Polo Team to help defray travelling expenses to attend the National Finals in Quebec City in May.

30. <u>Boy Scouts of Canada</u>	3,600.00

For each of the years 1982, 1983 and 1984 the grant approved for this organization was \$3,600.00. They are now requesting a similar grant for 1985 for the continuation of their work in our community.

31. <u>Burnaby Family Y. M. C. A.</u>	\$ 4,000.00

A request has been received from Marion Morris, Executive Director, Burnaby Family Y. M. C. A. for a grant in the amount of \$50,000.00 from the municipality's capital expansion fund.

This amount would allow the Burnaby Family Y. M. C. A. to meet their financial campaign target of \$100,000.00 to allow for the renovation of the existing building and the inclusion of an emergency child care center for infants up to 5 years of age.

Your Committee would recommend that \$4,000.00 be awarded to the Burnaby Family Y. M. C. A. to help defray costs of furniture and furnishings when the addition to the existing building is completed.

32. Burnaby Chamber of Commerce 20,500.00

The above organization received a grant in 1983 in the amount of \$21,500.00 and received a grant in 1984 in the amount of \$20,500.00.

Council will recall that a motion to grant \$40,000.00 to this organization was referred by Council to the Grants and Publicity Committee on 1985 April 01.

Your Committee would recommend that a grant in the amount of \$20,500.00 be awarded to the Burnaby Chamber of Commerce for 1985 to provide additional funding for the operation of the Information/Tourist Center.
