RECOMMENDATION:

REPORT:

At the present time we are unable to say if, and on which routes, traffic volumes have increased or decreased with the opening of Oakland Street. We did, however, include Burris Street in the list of streets that had traffic counts taken in 1984 July, and in about one month's time we will retake counts on all the area streets, including Burris Street, to evaluate the changes in traffic patterns.

We believe that the potential for accidents at the Burris/Sperling intersection is at this time largely conjectural, as we have not recorded a single reported accident since Oakland Street was opened. We are, nevertheless, monitoring traffic movements and accidents in the area and will be summarizing this information in a report to Council scheduled for sometime in July.

The subject of speeding in the area is being checked into by the R.C.M.P.
