SUBJECT: REQUEST OF ALPHA SECONDARY SCHOOL TO
CONDUCT A "PARADE".

The captioned request, as required under Section 23 of the Street and Traffic Bylaw, was to conduct a "Conga" line from the school to Brentwood Mall. The Engineering Department has no experience in the affect this type of activity may have on traffic, but we estimated that the line may take 30 minutes to pass a given point. This would result in the need to close, to all traffic, any road crossed or travelled for at least this period of time and the traffic detoured to alternate streets. As Parker Street was one of the streets crossed in the proposed routing, we felt that we could not support the request.

We relayed this information to the applicant along with alternate routing and staging area suggestions. The applicant, after consultation with other organizing committee members, decided to cancel the activity and withdraw their request for a "parade permit".
