Madam and Gentlemen:

Your Committee would report as follows:

Re: 1985 Burnaby Taptoe Festival (Application No. 37A)

As predicted, the Burnaby Taptoe Festival held on Saturday, September 21st, in the Swangard Stadium, was an outstanding success and augurs well for Burnaby's image of the future if it were to be held annually. The Chairman and members of the Taptoe Festival Committee and the numerous volunteers are to be commended for a job well done.

Council will recall that on May 27th, the Chairman of the Committee, Miss Ursula Hubel, appeared as a Delegation and advised that the festival budget would be approximately \$20,000. Miss Hubel also informed Council that in addition to a request for a municipal grant, donations would be sought from corporate and individual sources.

16 letters were sent to Burnaby businesses but only two responded. 108 letters were sent to Burnaby residents and to date only 15 have responded. Your Committee recommended and Council approved a grant in the amount of \$5,000. on 1985 July 15. For the information of Council, the following is a record of Receipts and Disbursements up to and including 1985 October 17:

Re: Hyack Swim Club (Application No. 24A)

We are advised that 30% of the swimmers in the Hyack Swim Club live and swim in Burnaby, as does their Public Relations Manager, Mr. Terry De Line. The team that was sent by the Club to compete in the 1985 Canada Games was successful in bringing home a Gold Medal, six Silver Medals a Bronze Medal, and also set a new B.C. Provincial Record in the 200 metre freestyle for girls.

The winner of the Gold Medal (Mr. Paul Block, a Burnaby resident) set a new Canadian record for youth (15 and under) in the Boys' 200 metre Butterfly. The winner of the Silver Medal in the 4 x 100 Medley Relay, is also a Burnaby resident, Miss Dina De Marchi.

Your Committee would recommend that \$300.00 be awarded the Hyack Swim Club to assist with the travelling expenses of these two champion Burnaby swimmers.
