RE: CONTRACT #8511 - BRUNETTE RIVER BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Miller Contracting Ltd., to perform the subject work for a total cost of \$396,000.00, with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered, subject to final adoption of the appropriate by-laws by the Councils of the City of New Westminster and the District of Coquitlam.

REPORT

Tenders for this project were received up to 3:00 p.m. local time, Wednesday, 1985 September 25.

The work of this contract includes the construction of the 23 metre long Brunette River Bridge and associated roadworks on North Road. The bridge will carry four traffic lanes and will be supported on steel piles.

The Director Engineering's estimate for this contract was \$450,000.00.

All work under this contract is to be completed within eighty (80) consecutive working days after commencement of construction but no later than 1986 April 30.

Eight (8) tenders were received and opened in the presence of municipal staff and representatives of the firms bidding.

A tabulation of the tenders received is attached (Attachment A).

A copy of the Schedule of Additional Unit Prices is attached (Attachment B).

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
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Funds for this project are provided in the 1985 capital budget. The total cost of this project is approximately \$694,000.00 and the subject contract is a part thereof. However, the total cost will be shared as follows: Province of B.C., Highways Grant - 50%; Burnaby - 25%; Coquitlam - 12 1/2%; and New Westminster - 12 1/2%. Since Burnaby is responsible for administering the project, the full funding must be in place and the shared costs will be recovered at the appropriate time.

By-law No. 8427, which authorizes an agreement among the communities involved, appears on the agenda of 1985 October 21 for reconsideration and final adoption. New Westminster Council has scheduled final reading of their by-law for Monday, 1985 October 21, and Coquitlam Council has scheduled theirs for Tuesday, 1985 October 22.

Our consultants, A.A. Williams & Associates Ltd. and McElhanney Engineering Services Ltd., and the Director Engineering concur with the above recommendation.

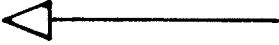
