RE: C.G. BROWN POOL ADDITION STAGE 2

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT the Commission approve a construction contract in the amount of \$146,039 be awarded to Tritan Construction Ltd. of 19416 - 94th Avenue, R.R. #4, Surrey, B.C., V3T 4W2 for the stage 2 addition to the C.G. Brown Memorial Pool.

2. THAT the Commission so recommend to Council.

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REPORT

The Commission at its 1985 June 19 meeting approved going to public tender for the C.G. Brown addition stage 2. Attachment I outlines the tenders received.

Attachment II is a letter from Carlberg Jackson Partners Architects recommending the low tender of Tritan Construction Ltd. be accepted, with the stated adjustment. The adjustment brings the contract price down to \$146,039.

The Acting Chief Building Inspector concurs in this recommendation.

The current status of the Capital Budget monies allocated for this project in 1985 is as follows:

	Spent to Date	Amount required	<u>Allocation</u>
Fees Contract	\$12,400 	\$ 14,604 146,039	\$ 15,650 144,350
TOTALS	\$12,400	\$160,643	\$160,000

The shortfall on the project is \$643.00. Included in the construction budget of \$146,039 is a contingency amount of \$5,000. This will be reduced to \$4,357 to cover the shortfall.

The main emphasis of the second stage is the completion of the shallow teaching pool and the addition of water slide features. During the first stage of this project all of the underground piping required for the completion of the teaching pool was put in place, with an access panel left in the existing sunken area.

The program areas where further participation is anticipated are as follows:

- 1. The continuing high demand for preschool programs, originating primarily from the North Burnaby area. Currently this demand cannot be satisfied due to lack of space in the existing pool.
- A demand by adults to be able to swim lengths at any time. Currently
 this is not possible during lesson programs, again due to lack of space
 in the pool.
- 3. The water slide features will attract more children and help promote a family atmosphere.

It is anticipated the second stage will increase the percentage recovery of this facility significantly.

Staff would recommend the awarding of the contract to Tritan Construction Ltd.

We have reviewed the tenders for the above named project and hereby recommend the low tender by Tritan Construction Ltd. be accepted with the following adjustment. The low tender of \$153,400.00 includes a \$30,000.00 cash allowance for the installation of the water slide. Since tenders have been received, Tritan Construction Ltd. has submitted a firm price on the slide in the amount of \$22,639.00 which we have reviewed and find acceptable.

We have worked with Tritan Construction Ltd. in the past and found them to be a competent and reliable firm. We therefore recommend that they be awarded a contract in the amount of \$146,039.00.
