Further to our report of 1985 09 04, Council meeting 1985 09 09, Manager's Report Item #19 (copy attached).

We have now received further correspondence from the Ministry of Transportation and Highways that they will be repaving over the existing chip seal with a standard asphalt mix. As tire/roadway interaction is the dominant source of traffic noise at highway speeds, the repaving should result in a perceptible reduction in Marine Way noise for residents north of Marine Drive.

A petition was received by Council at its regular meeting of 1985 June 24 regarding traffic noise emanating from the new Marine Way. The petition was signed by residents living in the area of the 5000 - 5100 blocks Keith and Patrick Streets.

In response to this petition we wrote to the District Manager, Ministry of Transportation and Highways on 1985 June 24 to ascertain what measures, if any, the Ministry was prepared to take to resolve the concerns of the petitioners.

We received a response from the District Manager on 1985 August 27 advising that the subject has been referred to the Ministry's Design Branch for their recommendations. When we receive their submission we will again report to Council.
