RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT Council grant approval to the Burnaby Hospital Foundation for the temporary placement of a Special Purpose Sign on public property for a maximum time period of fifteen (15) days, as more particularly described in this report.
2. THAT a copy of this report be sent to Mr. Colin Ryan, Campaign Chairman of Burnaby Hospital Foundation, 3935 Kincaid Street, Burnaby, B.C., V5G 2X6.

R E P O R T

A request has been received from Mr. Colin Ryan, Campaign Chairman of Burnaby Hospital Foundation's C.A.R.E. Campaign, for approval of a thermometer-type campaign progress sign to be situated on public property.

Provision is made in Schedule I(g) of the Burnaby Sign Bylaw 1972 for Council to consent to such a request, subject to an applicant's agreement in writing to remove the sign within three (3) days after the drive has concluded.

The Burnaby Hospital Foundation is a registered non-profit volunteer society whose purpose is to raise capital monies for the Burnaby General Hospital. They have recently commenced a fund-raising drive to assist in acquiring a \$1.9 million CAT scanner for the Hospital.

In conjunction with this drive, the Foundation proposes to utilize two freestanding "thermometer"-style signs measuring 2' wide by 7' high which will be located and moved from time to time during the campaign at various different locations throughout the Municipality, on privately-owned lands. The Sign Bylaw permits this type of temporary sign display by such civic or philanthropic organizations.

However, the Foundation wishes to obtain permission to locate one of these signs for short periods of time at a specific location where private land is not available. For this reason, they have requested that we seek Council's consent to placement of the sign on an unopened portion of public road allowance, adjacent to Century Park but not presently within property designated for parks purposes or under the jurisdiction of the Parks and Recreation Commission.

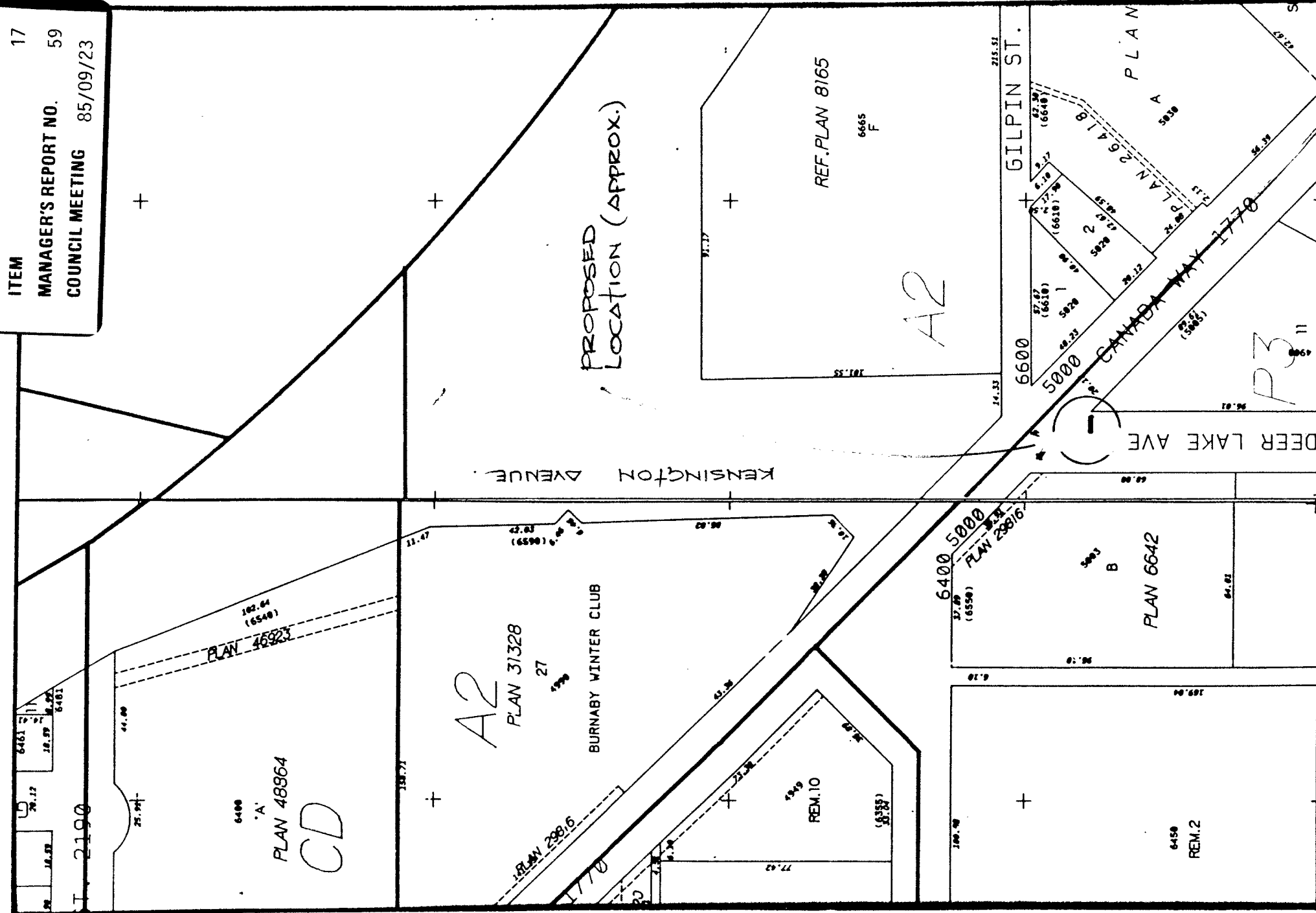
It is recommended that consent be given for this civic purpose on the terms outlined in this report.
