Your Committee would report as follows:

<u>Application No.</u>		<u>Recommendation</u>
32.	<u>Community-Centred College For The Retired</u>  The above College has been in operation in Burnaby since 1973. Its role is: (a) To study the needs of seniors; (b) To provide educational opportunities to expand their horizons and outlook; and (c) To bring self-help to seniors for the benefit of themselves and our community.  For several years, the College received a grant of \$1,000. from the Leon and Thea Koerner Foundation but this source of funds is no longer available to them.  Last year, Council approved a municipal grant of \$1,000. towards the continuation of this community programme and your Committee would again recommend that Council authorize a similar grant for 1985.	\$1,000.
33.	<u>The Vancouver Playhouse</u>  For a number of years, Council has approved an annual grant of \$5,000. for The Vancouver Playhouse.  Your Committee would again recommend that \$5,000. be awarded The Vancouver Playhouse for 1985.	\$5,000.
34.	<u>Vancouver Symphony Society</u>  For a number of years, Council has approved a grant in the amount of \$6,000. for the Vancouver Symphony Society.  Your Committee would again recommend that \$6,000. be awarded this Society for 1985.	\$6,000.
