In his letter Mr. MacLean asked Council to consider an amendment to the Burnaby Cab and Commercial Vehicle By-law No. 3102, which would permit the issuing of fifteen (15) new taxi cab licences to Imperial Taxi Ltd., a wholly owned subsidiary of Royal City Taxi.
