2. THAT the Returning Officer be authorized to appoint a deputy returning officer for each voting place.


R E P O R T

Section 84 of the "Municipal Act" provides in part:

- "84. (1) The Council shall, for the annual election and an election at other times as required, appoint a Returning Officer, - - -.
 The Council may delegate to the returning officer power to appoint a deputy returning officer.
- (2) No person shall be appointed by the council or by the returning officer for the purposes of an election who has been or is employed by another person in or about the election."

Section 30 of the "School Act" provides:

"30 The annual nomination and election of the number of trustees from all or part of a municipality that is necessary under this Act to maintain the requisite number of trustees for the municipality or the part of it on the board of the school district in which the municipality or the part of it is included shall be held at the same time and conducted in the same manner as the annual election of members of the council in the municipality, and by the returning officer appointed for that annual election."
