REPORT

Appearing on last week's agenda was a letter from Gillian Neumann regarding parking on Ledger Avenue.

Council received a previous letter from the correspondent on 1985 March 11. An investigation that was carried out at that time resulted in the creation of two additional parking spaces in the 4200 Block of Ledger Avenue (Item 9, Report No. 21 which Council received on 1985 March 18). It is the opinion of staff that the creation of any additional parking spaces will jeopardize the sight-lines of existing traffic from adjacent parking lots. It is felt, from a safety point of view, that the parking regulations that now exist best serve the public's interest and should, therefore, not be the subject of any further change at this time.
