INTRODUCTION

On the Council agenda for 1985 July 29 is a letter from Mrs. Donna Gyurcsek of 3722 Manor Street, Burnaby, regarding the application status of the "group that occupy 3012 Boundary Road". On 1985 May 27 the Licence Department received an application from Lori Rider (Quality Time Productions) for a licence to engage in a business of providing personal development, time management workshops and seminars.

The applicant previously operated in the City of Vancouver but was put on notice by Vancouver to cease operating in a residential zone, and to seek appropriate commercial facilities if they wished to continue their operations in Vancouver.

REPORT

INVESTIGATION OF APPLICATION

The Licence Department has investigated whether or not the applicant meets the conditions of licencing in Burnaby. The Licence Department has also initiated enquiries through the R.C.M.P. and Vancouver City Police to determine if there was any evidence of illegal or unlawful activities in the applicant's business. These police authorities found no evidence of illegal or unlawful activities. The Licence Department has found no reason why the application should be denied, pending the required approvals by the Planning and Building Inspection, Health, and Fire Departments. Therefore the applicant will be in a position to receive her business licence when the necessary associated departmental approvals are given.

Subsequently, if any illegal or unlawful activities were carried out by the applicant it would fall under the jurisdiction of the Burnaby R.C.M.P., who would have to address such matters.
