REPORT OF THE COMMUNITY STANDARDS COMMITTEE  
RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT Council approve the Community Standards Committee proposal to conduct a series of community forums for the purpose of receiving vocal expressions and opinions from the community regarding community standards in Burnaby.
2. THAT identified service clubs serving the municipality be contacted requesting sponsorship and participation in the proposed community forums.

R E P O R T

The Community Standards Committee, at their meeting held on Thursday, 1985 May 23 held a lengthy discussion regarding a proposed plan of action for creating public awareness on the topic of community standards as it relates to obscenity.

The deadline for receipt of all written submissions has now passed and, to date, a total of approximately fifty (50) written submissions have been received by the Committee which is felt to have demonstrated a genuine concern on the subject.

As a result of this demonstrated public concern, your Committee has responded by proposing a series of community forums to allow the community to provide input by vocally addressing the subject, thereby providing public awareness.

Your Committee further agreed that service clubs, as identified through a listing provided by the Burnaby Chamber of Commerce, be contacted requesting they take an active role in the proposed community forums by providing sponsorship and/or participation.

In conclusion, it is realized that there may be undetermined costs associated with the holding of the community forums and will be the subject of a further report to Council at a later date.
