REPORT:

As noted in the submission, Beulah Darling was notified that noise attenuation measures would not be considered on Oakland Street. Under the Burnaby Conceptual Transportation Plan the only classification of street considered for such treatment would be arterials.

In responding to the statement that some homeowners have been given special treatment, we can only advise that the majority of boulevards are simply being seeded in grass. Some areas require special treatment because of the topography and we have decided to treat them with a more expensive but lower maintenance cost ivy covering. The only other treatment is the planting of boulevard trees, which will be spaced throughout the entire length of the project.
