REPORT:

The captioned request, copy attached, has been received from the Cariboo Hill Temple of the Salvation Army. The parade is intended to commemorate the opening of the Army's new facility at 7195 Cariboo Road. As the parade is of such a short duration and will only occupy the southbound lane of Cariboo Road, we do not feel this parade will present any problems. Therefore, we are recommending that Council approve the request subject to the following conditions, that:

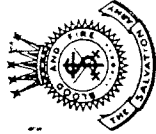
1. The parade be conducted on the requested route at the time specified in the request; and

Dear Sirs:


We are planning a grand opening of our new facilities at the above address on Saturday, June 15, 1985.
