HIS WORSHIP THE MAYOR
AND MEMBERS OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL:

Madam and Gentlemen:

On 1985 November 12, Council took the following action with respect to the item indicated:

"Application 54 - The Food Bank

Council awarded a grant in the sum of \$5,000.00 for 1985.

NOTE: Alderman Drummond suggested that the Committee consider The Food Bank for further funding when deliberating on the disposition of any remaining 1985 funds."

Your Committee has determined that there are sufficient funds remaining in the Grants budget to allow for the following expenditure:

In reviewing the application, we find that Burnaby has donated the same amount, or in many cases more than other municipalities to the Greater Vancouver area Food Bank. However, as we have received a special request from the Burnaby Food Bank at West Burnaby United Church for "candies and oranges for the children at Christmas time", distributors were contacted and an offer made to match donations of oranges, dollar for dollar in an amount of up to \$1,000.

Canada Safeway Limited has agreed to accept our offer and will provide \$2,000. worth of oranges to the Burnaby Food Bank, providing that Council approves your Committee's recommendation, viz.

"THAT a grant of up to \$1,000. be authorized to purchase a supply of oranges for the Burnaby Food Bank to match an equivalent donation."
