REPORT:

1. Burnaby Detachment R.C.M.P. has been actively involved in Crime Prevention for a number of years, involving Auxiliary Constables, Service Clubs and members of the general public, and spends 11 person years on that endeavor; thirty per cent of the time exchanging ideas with schools, business organizations and community groups.
2. Together with the Rotary Club of Burnaby/Kingsway and the Auxiliary Police, we have plans to undertake new programs in the areas of bicycle and child identification while re-activating our Neighbourhood Watch Program.
3. I recommend against the Co-ordinator's proposal that the municipality initiate a Crime Prevention Committee, at a time when the Detachment has insufficient resources to take on new responsibilities without additional manpower. Especially, when we are already committed to the involvement of the community in our current and planned projects.
