SUBJECT: PROPOSED BY-LAW TO REMOVE  
ILLEGAL PORTABLE SIGNS

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a by-law be prepared and presented to Council for the removal of illegal portable signs.

REPORT:

On four occasions in 1984, and twice in 1985, Council received information reports outlining the Building Inspection Division's progress in enforcement of the Burnaby Sign By-Law with respect to illegally displayed portable signs. Council subsequently passed Burnaby Sign Removal Authorization By-Laws providing for the removal of particular signs where the owners or occupants had failed to remove them following proper notice.

A summary of current statistics is provided:

Total number of offending locations recorded to date: 180

Signs voluntarily removed 159  
Signs impounded under municipal by-laws 15  
Outstanding signs being processed 6


Signs to be dealt with under the proposed by-law as follows:

It is requested that a by-law be prepared under Section 735 of the Municipal Act to authorize the removal of three outstanding illegal portable signs.
