RECOMMENDATION:

R E P O R T

During the Council meeting of 1986 June 9, a question was raised as to whether or not there were reports outstanding to Council regarding the emission levels from the Burnaby incinerator.

A review of the most recent report to Council, dated 1986 March 03, indicates that a further report was to be submitted to Council when plant air emissions and community ambient air monitoring requirements are established by the Ministry of the Environment. In reviewing the progress on this subject with the Chief Public Health Inspector, I am advised that Ministry of Environment officials are still working on preparing for the Minister's approval requirements regarding both incinerator stack emissions and community ambient air quality monitoring. Officials of the Environmental Health Division of the Burnaby Health Department are actively involved in that process. No precise date is yet known as to when those final recommendations regarding the requirements for the incinerator will be forwarded to the Minister of the Environment.

Once we have been advised of those recommended requirements, a report will be submitted to Council, indicating the views of Environmental Health staff as to the adequacy of the requirements.

This report is submitted for the information of Council.
