RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT an amendment to the 1987 Burnaby Recreation Facility Fees Bylaw reflecting the new rate for private use of studios at the Burnaby Arts Centre as outlined in this report be brought forward by the Municipal Solicitor.

REPORT

At its meeting of 1986 November 05 the Parks & Recreation Commission received a staff report recommending an amendment to the 1987 Burnaby Recreation Facility Fees Bylaw. The report responds to a written request to the Commission from a current user of meeting space at the Burnaby Arts Centre for a reduction in the existing rate.


The correspondent utilizes space at the Arts Centre during weekday daytime hours to conduct specialized training programs for social workers and child care workers.

The present fee structure for this type of non-recreational private use is \$16.00 per hour. The recreational non-profit use rate is \$2.00 per hour.

Staff have reviewed the rates charged for similar space by other private and public agencies and consequently recommend that the existing rate of \$16.00 per hour for private users be reduced between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on weekdays to \$8.00 per hour and \$250.00 per week (Monday through Friday).

The Commission approved the following recommendation relating to the new rate structure:

"THAT the 1987 Burnaby Recreation Facility Fees Bylaw be amended to include a non-prime time rate for the use of the Burnaby Arts Centre studios, as outlined in this report."
