RECOMMENDATION:

THAT this report be received for information purposes.

R E P O R T

On 1985 October 21, Council adopted Bylaw No. 8420 which is a bylaw authorizing the expenditure of monies in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund. The bylaw authorized expenditure of \$1.773 million for the construction of Deer Lake Place/Norland Avenue and Park Drive and designing and acquiring right-of-way for intersection improvements on Canada Way.

Council had previously received a report on 1985 August 12 which provided a cost breakdown of the three projects included in the bylaw. Tenders for these works have been called and it is now possible to more accurately define the apportionment of costs.

Cost division is as follows:

Construction of Deer Lake Place/Norland Avenue and associated right-of-way acquisitions	\$1,273,000	\$1,123,000
Construction of Park Drive between Sperling Avenue and Dale Avenue including the construction of a bridge over Deer Lake Brook	350,000	550,000
Design and right-of-way acquisitions for left turn channelization and intersection improvements on Canada Way between Norland and Kensington Avenues	150,000	100,000
TOTAL	\$1,773,000	\$1,773,000

These revisions do not require any amendment to the existing Bylaw No. 8420 and this report is only for the information of Council.
