SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT OF BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council adopt the following resolution appointing  
JOHN MURRAY PARKINS to be a Bylaw Enforcement Officer:

"BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to the power vested in it by section 29 of the Police Act, C.331, R.S.B.C. 1979, does hereby appoint as Bylaw Enforcement Officer in and for the District of Burnaby

**JOHN MURRAY PARKINS**

who shall, under the direction of the Officer-in-Charge of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Burnaby Detachment, enforce the Street and Traffic Bylaw and other Bylaws of the Municipality and for that purpose has the powers of a constable and all the powers and immunities contained in any of the said Bylaws."

**R E P O R T**

The 1986 RCMP budget includes provision for an additional part-time Bylaw Enforcement Officer mid-way through the year, and an increased revenue as a result. One of the existing full-time officers has opted to take that part-time position, with the result that an appointment is now being made to fill the vacant full-time position.

Mr. John Parkins has been hired as a full-time Bylaw Enforcement Officer to replace Edward Mundie who will act part-time as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer. Council is empowered to appoint Bylaw Enforcement Officers by the Police Act.
