R E P O R T

The request, from Raylene Burke, Coordinator of Volunteers in the Health Department, is to close Conway Avenue from Kingsway to Arbroath Street and to close Arbroath Street from Conway Avenue to the western end of the Burnaby South School property. Also included in this closure would be the lane south of and paralleling Kingsway. The purpose of these closures is for the marshalling of participants in the Wheel-a-thon (see attached information).

We feel this closure on the date and time requested will not create any undue problems as both the adjacent school and the restaurant are not normally occupied at that time. The R.C.M.P. were consulted on this matter and concur with the recommendation.
