REPORT

Further to receipt of a letter addressed to the Mayor and Council from Mr. G. Buss, 837 Wyvern Court, Coquitlam, B.C., regarding a sewage type odor in the vicinity of Como Lake Road and Gaglardi Way, we would advise as follows.

Upon receipt of the correspondence, the District Public Health Inspector immediately conducted an inspection of the storm drainage area in the vicinity of Como Lake Road and Gaglardi Way.

The Inspector did not locate a discharge in this particular storm drainage area.

As Mr. Buss was unable to be reached by telephone, a letter has been forwarded to his residence requesting that he immediately contact our office. Upon contact with Mr. Buss arrangements will be made to accompany him to the area which he is concerned with.

Should any type of discharge be found, the District Public Health Inspector will immediately order its removal under either Municipal Bylaw or the Provincial Health Act.
