Madam and Gentlemen:

I am very pleased to announce that the Prince and Princess of Wales will be in Burnaby for a municipal visit on 1986 May 06. They will arrive by Skytrain at the Patterson Street station at 10:15 a.m. and travel by motorcade along Patterson and Kingsway to Central Park where they will unveil a plaque commemorating the opening of Variety Park. They are scheduled to depart from Burnaby for Vancouver at approximately 11:00 a.m.

The program for the ceremony at the Park is now being prepared. Basically, it will involve the Prince and Princess being greeted when they arrive at the Park by members of Council, their spouses, representatives of the Variety Club, the Chairman of the Parks and Recreation Commission, his spouse and perhaps a few others as well. The Royalty will then be escorted to a dais where the formal municipal welcome will take place. The Prince will then unveil a plaque to commemorate the dedication of Variety Park. The event at Central Park will conclude with a short walk in Variety Park.

It is a great honour for us to have the Prince and Princess visit Burnaby, and I know that the entire community will extend the warmest of welcomes to them during the time they are with us.
