RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council authorize the release of \$13,600 from the 1986 Parks and Recreation Provisional Capital Budget, prior to Annual Budget approval, to enable immediate upgrading of the archway entrance washrooms in Central Park in connection with the development of the Variety Club Park.

REPORT

At its meeting of 1986 February 19 the Parks & Recreation Commission received a staff report requesting that \$13,600 of its 1986 Provisional Capital Budget be reallocated in order to permit upgrading of the Central Park archway washrooms. This work would be done in conjunction with modifications to the washrooms which will be undertaken by the Variety Club as part of its special needs playground project.

The Variety Club will build a small addition onto the existing washroom which will provide only for the handicapped, plus one room inside the existing facility will be modified to a special child care washroom.

The Commission would undertake the following improvements:

- 1) Upgrade electrical service.
- 2) Install new lights, heaters and hot water service.
- 3) Repaint the exterior and interior.
- 4) Replace old wooden stall dividers with metal partitions.
- 5) Replace old style wall hung sinks and urinals with more contemporary accessories.



As the playground opening is scheduled for 1986 May 06, staff also requested approval to spend the funds prior to the passage of the 1986 Annual Budget.

The Commission approved the following recommendations of the report:

1. THAT the Commission reallocate \$13,600 of its 1986 Provisional Capital Budget from the Deer Lake Park read-o-graph sign to the renovation of the Central Park archway entrance washrooms and that the Deer Lake Park read-o-graph sign be deleted from the budget.
2. THAT the Commission request Council to authorize the release of these funds from the 1986 Provisional Capital Budget prior to Annual Budget approval.
