RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the request for a grant from AIDS Vancouver be tabled until the Metropolitan Board of Health considers a request for support that it has also received as more specifically noted in this report.

REPORT

Mr. Bob Tivey, in his letter to Council, requests that each Municipality in the Lower Mainland give a grant in the amount of \$10,000 to AIDS Vancouver.

The City of Vancouver's Health Department asked the Metropolitan Board of Health, at its meeting on 1986 September 24, to support AIDS Vancouver in its attempts to get funding from the Provincial Government (it should be noted that the Board does not have funding of its own to give to AIDS Vancouver, and that the request to the Board for support is more in the form of an endorsement). The Board tabled this request for consideration at its next meeting on 1986 October 22.

Following is additional background information on AIDS Vancouver in terms of its overall objectives:

- To deliver public awareness and education programs on Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) and AIDS-Related Complex (ARC) for the general public and high-risk groups;
- To deliver support programs to people with AIDS and ARC;
- To develop a network of AIDS-concerned organizations.
