1. THAT Council authorize the execution of a contract with Carlberg Jackson Partners for the design and supervision services for the Kensington Park Rink Community Recreation Offices project.

REPORT


The Parks and Recreation Commission has \$80,000 within its 1986 Capital Budget for the development of Community Recreation office space at Kensington Park Rink.

The office space will house the four staff delivering community recreation activities in the North Burnaby area. There are three such geographic areas. This is part of a Commission program of decentralization of recreation coordinating staff into their area of operation. East Burnaby staff are housed in Eastburn Recreation Centre and South Burnaby staff will eventually be housed in the new Bonsor Recreation Centre.

The Municipal Building Project Coordination Committee recommended to the Commission the retention of Carlberg Jackson Partners, the original designers of the rink. The Commission approved the selection of this firm.

The architect fees are estimated at \$7,273, based on 10% of the estimated construction cost. The actual architect fees will be adjusted to reflect the tendered project cost.

Council is now requested to authorize the execution of a contract with Carlberg Jackson Partners for the project design and supervision services.
