RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT a purchase order be issued to the lowest acceptable bidder, Crocker Equipment Co. Ltd., for the supply and delivery of two (2) only 1987 Ford C8000 cab-over trucks complete with 1987 Camel 200MCB catch basin emptiers for a total sum of \$261,028.64.

REPORT

Tenders for the subject equipment were received up to 3:00 p.m. local time, Thursday, 1986 September 04.

Seven (7) tenders were received and opened by Municipal staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding.


The two (2) units to be purchased will replace a 1974 Ford chassis with a Vac-All catch basin emptier (Unit No. 203) and a 1977 Ford chassis with a Vac-All catch basin emptier (Unit No 119), both of which will be sold at auction following delivery of the replacement units.

The replacement of the units is provided for in the 1986 Capital Budget with funds coming from the Equipment Replacement Reserve.

- A tabulation of the tenders received is attached (Attachment A). The following are comments on the bids received:
- Vimar Machinery Ltd. did not include in their tendered prices several items called for in the specifications.
 - Some of these items were listed in a supplementary price schedule. The addition of these specified items revises all four Vimar bids upwards by an amount of \$56,470.86, however they still fail to meet our specifications. Bids 1(b) and 1(c) have been submitted on the basis of a 6 cu. yd. load capacity rather than the 9 cu. yd. capacity specified. In addition, all four Vimar bids were tendered on the basis of fan operated lifting mechanisms rather than the positive displacement pump lifting mechanism specified.
 - The lowest bid which meets our specification is submitted by Crocker Equipment Ltd.
 - The Engineering Department has had the recommended unit quoted by Crocker Equipment Co. Ltd., demonstrated and found it to be more efficient and much quieter than the conventional fan-operated units such as that quoted in the low tender from Vimar and those presently in service in our fleet. The Engineering Department has also surveyed several 4 to 6 year users of the make and model of equipment specified in our tender and is completely satisfied that the equipment will perform as expected. It is further anticipated that a marked increase in productivity will be seen as a result of the state-of-the-art lifting mechanism specified in our tender and included in the recommended unit.

The Director Engineering concurs with the above recommendation.
