
SUMMARY:

A letter from Mr. Kearns directed to the "Mayor and City Council" referred to the RCMP issuing violation tickets for illegally parked vehicles on Sunday morning 1986 MAY 11.

REPORT:

The police were summoned to the scene, where it was reported that the illegally parked vehicles in a "no parking zone" were preventing commercial transportation from utilizing the designated "Bus Stop" area.

Two police vehicles in the area responded, and a total of five tickets were issued to the registered owner of the vehicles who had parked in the "no parking area", which is said to be very clearly marked.
