ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Council, at its meeting of 1985 February 04, approved the above work order in the amount of \$15,000, primarily to finance the preliminary study on Royal Oak Avenue route selection. Consultant services required to assist the Municipality in preparing displays, drawings, and other information for the Public Open House dealing with Deer Lake Park Development and the new alignment of Royal Oak Avenue between Grange and Gilpin, have now been more closely defined. Funds are provided in the 1987 Capital Contingency.
