The R.C.M.P. has acknowledged the letter that appears on the agenda from
the Mountainside Village Strata Council NW 2175. This was done in the
form of a letter dated 1987 May 06 from the Officer in Charge of
Operations which advised as follows:

"I have asked Cst. David Baigent of our Community Policing/Crime
Prevention Unit to meet with you and come up with an action plan
to address the situation. The suggestion that the problem is a
lost cause, or that people should move out of the area, is not
shared by this office.

You may be assured that your concerns will be given priority, and
you may expect our utmost co-operation."

An initial meeting between the Mountainside Village Strata Council and the
R.C.M.P. is expected to take place in the very near future. It should be
noted that some of the concerns expressed by the Strata Council,
especially regarding United Properties' representations, are more of a
contract/civil law nature and beyond the jurisdiction of the municipality.
