REPORT

Further to receipt of a copy of a petition to Municipal Council from residents of the 5800 Block McKee Street regarding noise disturbances at 5822 McKee Street we would advise as follows.

Prior to receiving a copy of the subject petition, a complaint was received by the Environmental Health Division on 1987 March 24 regarding noise disturbances at 5822 McKee Street. On 1987 March 26, the District Public Health Inspector hand delivered a notice to the occupant of 5822 McKee Street. The notice required immediate compliance with the requirements of the Burnaby Noise Bylaw.

We have discussed this report with the original complainant who advised that the situation has improved. The complainant was further advised to contact this Division using our 24-hour emergency number should there be any recurrence of disturbing noise levels from 5822 McKee Street.

Should this Division be contacted and noise level readings determine that there is a violation of the Burnaby Noise Bylaw, charges will be forwarded to the Crown Prosecutor.

For the information of Council, the latest Court case for a violation of the Burnaby Noise Bylaw due to stereo/party type of noise, resulted in a fine of \$150.
