RE: BURNABY TEACHERS' CHOIR PARTICIPATION IN
LOUGHBOROUGH SINGING WEEK, 1987 JULY 26 TO AUGUST 2

Madam and Gentlemen:

At the 1987 March 9 meeting of Municipal Council, Mayor Lewarne submitted a report on the proposed participation by the Burnaby Teachers' Choir in the Loughborough Singing Week, 1987 July 26 to August 6.

The Mayor's recommendation was:

"That the Grants & Publicity Committee consider a \$5,000 grant to the Burnaby Teachers' Choir to assist their attendance at Loughborough's Singing Week."

Council approved this and the three additional recommendations of Mayor Lewarne concerning the proposed participation by the Burnaby Teachers' Choir in the Loughborough Singing Week and attendance by Council and Management Committee members as an official delegation to our Sister-city in 1987.

After due consideration, your Committee is in support of the Mayor's recommendation. However, this request does not fall within the guidelines of the Grants & Publicity Committee for awarding grant funds.

It is the opinion and recommendation of the Committee that \$5,000 be designated by Council to assist the Burnaby Teachers' Choir, and that it be charged as an expense against the appropriate Sister-city budget account.
