
SUMMARY:

A letter dated 87-10-19 was directed to Burnaby Municipal Council advising that their neighborhood was being terrorized by juveniles who were hanging around the 8600 block of Forest Grove, drinking, swearing, squealing tires and impeding traffic. These activities were preventing area residents from enjoying the use of their property.

REPORT:

The concerns raised by Mr. & Mrs. KIRK were previously addressed in May of this year because of complaints by Mountainside Village Strata Council. As a result of our policing efforts we were advised by Mr. Mike Buckingham, Mountainside Village Strata Council, as of July that the problems had all but disappeared. Strata Council were looking into the introduction of Strata Bylaws to minimize further occurrences. Our Community Policing/Crime Prevention Unit made several recommendations which included, improved lighting, locking gates or stairwells, and removing visual obstructions to inhibit loitering in the roadway area which is unfortunately shared by business premises and residential housing.

We have stepped up patrols in the area by both regular and auxiliary members which has already had the desired effect. As of today, Mrs. KIRK advises that the last two weeks have been very pleasant. Workload permitting, patrols will continue to monitor this area.
