R E P O R T

As Council is well aware, the Crime Prevention Committee has been examining ways of effectively dealing with crime and the prevention thereof in Burnaby over the past several months. As part of this process a Crime Prevention Survey was circulated within the municipality and three (3) public meetings were held in north, south and central Burnaby for the purpose of receiving input from the public with respect to their concerns on the subject.

The Crime Prevention Survey results, and an analysis of those results, has been made available to the Committee. This information has provided an opportunity for the Committee to focus on the major concerns of the public as expressed through the public participation phase of the Committee's overall agenda. The Committee agrees that this information should now be communicated publicly.

Therefore, it is recommended that a public meeting be hosted by the Crime Prevention Committee, on behalf of Council, to advise of the results of the Crime Prevention Survey, provide a brief analysis of those results, and inform the public of the possible recommendations to Council which may be proposed by the Committee.
