SURREY LOVE IN ACTION SOCIETY

RECOMMENDATION

\$6,000

As Council will recall, this application was referred back to the Grants & Publicity Committee on 1986 November 24, following the appearance of a delegation from the Surrey Love in Action Society regarding their proposal to open a youth drop-in centre in Burnaby.

Your Committee has reconsidered this request and unanimously recommends a one-time startup grant be awarded to the Surrey Love in Action Society in the amount of \$6,000, on the condition that funds be released when the Society provides evidence to staff that the service is in place in a suitable Burnaby location.

BURNABY VOLUNTEER CENTRE

\$4,150

A request for assistance has been received from the Burnaby Volunteer Centre in order to fund the startup of the new Resource Development Project. This project will attempt to link the needs of the voluntary sector with available non-monetary resources of the business/corporate sector.

Your Committee has heard representatives from the Burnaby Volunteer Centre explain the project in detail and would recommend a one-time startup grant in the amount of \$4,150 be awarded to commence Phases I and II of the Resource Development Project.
