REPORT

Further to receipt of correspondence addressed to the Mayor and Council from the British Columbia Medical Association, Council on Health Promotion and Mrs. S. McHendry, 4-7459 Twelfth Avenue, Burnaby, regarding the topic of Non-Smoking Bylaws, we would advise as follows.

Health Department staff are currently working on a report for Municipal Council which will contain recommendations for a Bylaw regulating smoking within this Municipality. It is anticipated that the report will be submitted to Council in six weeks.

For Council's information, B.C. Transit allows transit operators to smoke in their vehicles during breaks providing they are not in violation of a municipal or city Non-Smoking Bylaw.

The forthcoming report to Council will contain recommendations regarding smoking on public transit operating within this municipality.

Mrs. S. McHendry has been advised of the contents of this report.
