RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the Municipal Clerk, Mr. Charles Anthony Turpin, be appointed Returning Officer for The Corporation of the District of Burnaby for the 1987 Municipal Election;
2. THAT the Returning Officer be authorized to appoint a deputy returning officer for each voting place.

R E P O R T

The 1987 Municipal Election will be held on November 21. Preparation for this election has already begun and therefore it is appropriate to appoint a Returning Officer at this time.

A full Enumeration is planned for April and May subject to legislative changes which may result in amendments to those sections of the Municipal Act relating to Elections. The estimated cost of the Enumeration has been provided for in the 1987 Provisional Budget. The Enumeration will be the subject of a further report to Council prior to the end of March.

The sections of the Municipal Act and School Act which pertain to this matter read as follows:

Section 84 of the "Municipal Act" provides:

- "84. (1) The council shall, for the annual election and an election at other times as required, appoint a returning officer, designate a nomination place, one or more voting places and appoint a deputy returning officer for each voting place. The council may delegate to the returning officer power to appoint a deputy returning officer.
- (2) No person shall be appointed by the council or by the returning officer for the purposes of an election who has been or is employed by another person in or about the election."

Section 30 of the "School Act" provides:

- "30 The annual nomination and election of the number of trustees from all or part of a municipality that is necessary under this Act to maintain the requisite number of trustees for the municipality or the part of it on the board of the school district in which the municipality or the part of it is included shall be held at the same time and conducted in the same manner as the annual election of members of the council in the municipality, and by the returning officer appointed for that annual election."
