RECOMMENDATION:

REPORT

At its meeting of 1987 February 18, the Parks & Recreation Commission received a report advising that a report from the Director Engineering recommending a new alignment for Royal Oak Avenue would appear on the 1987 March 02 Council Agenda.

The Commission was provided with a sketch of the new alignment and discussed it in some detail. As a result of these discussions the Commission approved the following recommendation:

"THAT the Commission advise Council that it has no objection to the use of the Deer Lake parklands as outlined on the attached sketch for a future realigned Royal Oak Avenue."

However, the recommendation was approved on the understanding that Council be made aware of several design concerns.

Primarily the Commission wishes to emphasize the importance of a substantial pedestrian underpass of Royal Oak in order to provide pleasant and easy access to the park areas on both sides of Royal Oak and to suggest that amenities such as bicycle paths be provided for.

The Commission would appreciate the opportunity to participate in the continued planning for the development of the Oakalla lands.
