RE: TERMS OF REFERENCE

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council adopt the following as the Terms of Reference of the Crime Prevention Committee:
 1. To identify the agencies involved in crime prevention and the services provided.
 2. To identify gaps and overlaps in the above services.
 3. To seek input from experts in related fields.
 4. To identify the public's concerns.
 5. To provide the opportunity for input from the general public by means of written briefs and presentations at public meetings.
 6. To increase public awareness of community responsibility in crime prevention.
 7. To present a report to Council containing recommendations for a proposed course of action.

R E P O R T

His Worship, Mayor Lewarne, in his Inaugural Address, at the Council Inaugural meeting held on 1986 December 08, advised of the planned expansion of the Crime Prevention Committee. Mayor Lewarne stated as follows:

"Their mandate is broad, so that they can hold public meetings to find out the problems in our community. The Committee will closely liaise with the R.C.M.P. on such matters as breaking and entering, drug problems, juvenile liquor abuse, etc. This Committee will report its recommendations to Council by December 1987."

Upon request of the Chairman of the Crime Prevention Committee, Committee members, at their meeting held on 1987 January 22 submitted written briefs outlining their concerns and/or suggestions relative to crime prevention.
