REPORT

Further to receipt of a copy of correspondence addressed to Mayor and Council from Mr. C.K. Campbell, 4729 E. Hastings Street, we would forward the following information pertaining to complaints of unsightly premises at adjoining properties.

On 1987 March 05 the District Public Health Inspector conducted inspections of adjoining properties to 4729 E. Hastings Street. As a result of the inspection a notice requesting compliance with the Burnaby Unsightly Premises Bylaw was forwarded to the occupant of 4737 E. Hastings Street. In addition the Burnaby Engineering Department was requested to remove litter from the Municipal Boulevard of the vacant lot adjoining Mr. Campbell's place of business.

Further inspections of these properties will be conducted by the District Public Health Inspector to ensure compliance with the Burnaby Unsightly Premises Bylaw.

Environmental Health Division staff are attempting to contact Mr. Campbell in order that an explanation can be given on the action taken on his complaint to Council.
