ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: In a previous report to Council on the subject of setting boundaries for the proposed conservation area on the north face of Capitol Hill, Council directed staff to prepare a further report containing soils-related information for that area. In determining the boundaries, soils information is indeed an important component; this work order allows for the required geotechnical work.

The 1987 Provisional Capital Budget contains a total of \$4,000,000 for all Land Assembly and Development programs for 1987, of which this is only a small part. The 1987 Annual Budget will present further specific details concerning the 1987 program.
