SUBJECT: NEW STREET NAME  
RENAME GILPIN STREET BETWEEN DEER LAKE PLACE  
AND DEER LAKE AVENUE TO DEER LAKE AVENUE

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council authorize the preparation and introduction of a bylaw to amend the street name of that portion of Gilpin Street between Deer Lake Place and Deer Lake Avenue to DEER LAKE AVENUE, as more particularly outlined in this report.

R E P O R T

Gilpin Street was named under Bylaw No. 135 on 1912 June 04.

The completion of the new park road from Sperling Avenue west to Gilpin Street, together with a re-alignment of the Gilpin Street/Deer Lake Place intersection, has prompted us to review the existing street names in this area.

As can be noted on the attached sketch, there is now a continuous road connection between Sperling Avenue and Deer Lake Place to the west. We have assigned for use the street name of Deer Lake Avenue to the section of the new road immediately west of Sperling Avenue. The residents on Deer Lake Avenue (running north/south between Gilpin Street and the new road) have expressed a strong desire to maintain this street name. Part of the continuous road connection is named Gilpin Street.

To avoid potential confusion resulting from the use of two names for one continuous section of road, it is recommended that the portion of Gilpin Street between Deer Lake Place and Deer Lake Avenue be changed to Deer Lake Avenue, the bylaw amended accordingly, the affected residents and Municipal branches (Health building, R.C.M.P. building, Art Gallery and Arts Centre) notified and the street signs changed.

We are, therefore, seeking Council authority to have the original street naming bylaw amended accordingly.

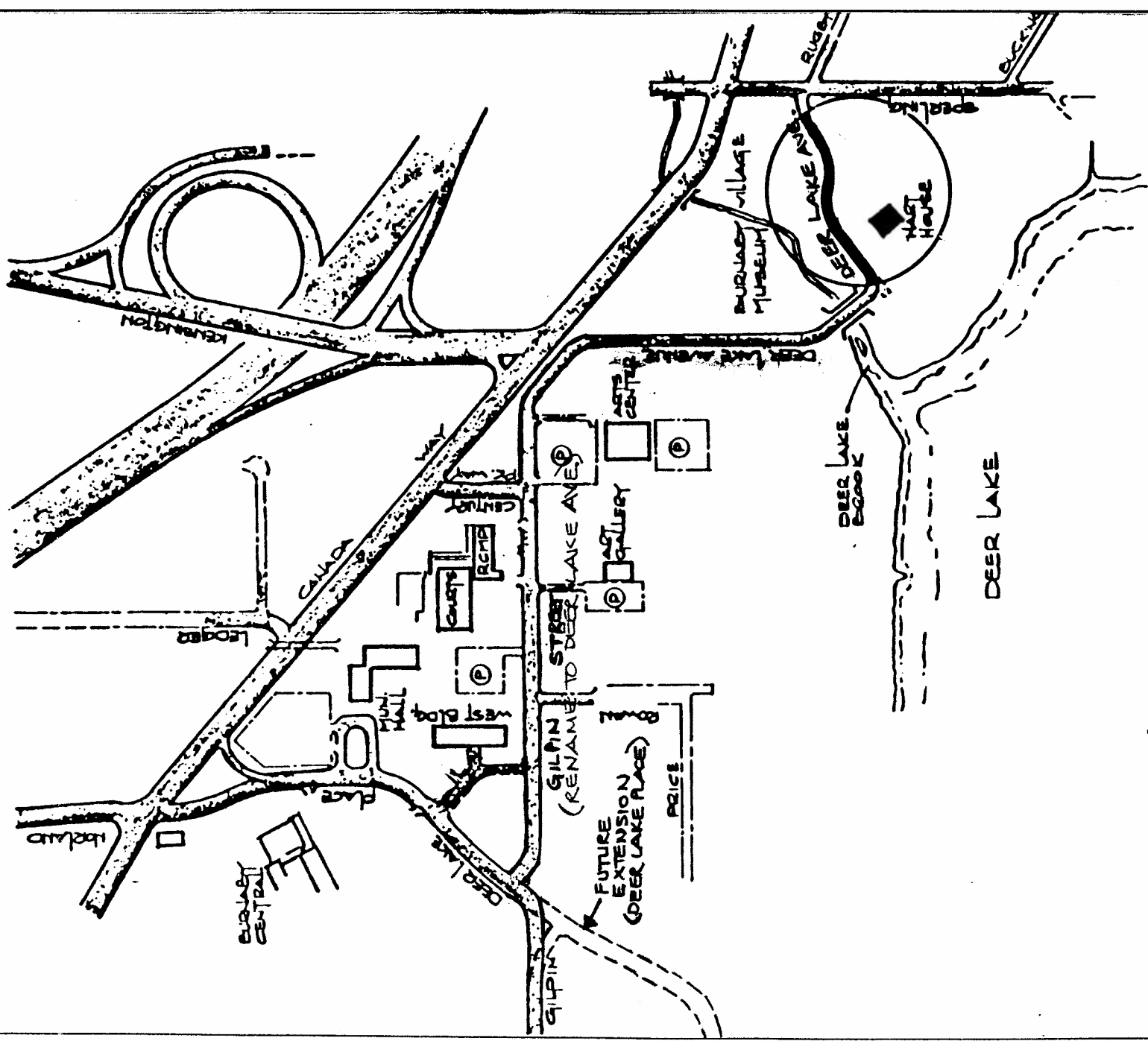
