Your Committee would report as follows:

40/86	<u>BRITISH COLUMBIA CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL</u> Your Committee has received an application from the B.C. Children's Hospital for a grant in an unspecified amount.	\$1,000

Since the guidelines for consideration of applications specify that donations must be made towards the purchase of equipment and not for on-going operational costs, your Committee recommends a one-time contribution of \$1,000 and has requested a copy of the B.C. Children's Hospital "Wish List" in order to specify the equipment to be purchased with Burnaby's donation.

41/86 OUTDOORS UNLITTERED

Appearing on the agenda for the 1986 December 15 meeting of Council was a letter from Outdoors Unlittered requesting a contribution of \$100 from Council to support the Pitch-In Anti-litter and Beautification Campaign in 1987.

Although this application for funds does not fall within the guidelines for approval by the Grants & Publicity Committee, your Committee would have no objections if Council approved the request for \$100 and this amount was charged to the Grants & Publicity Committee account.

43/86 VANCOUVER SYMPHONY SOCIETY \$7,000

The Vancouver Symphony Society has submitted a request for a Burnaby Council grant in the amount of \$10,000.

The Vancouver Symphony Orchestra has, for many years, provided an outstanding cultural resource to our community. Council has awarded the Society a grant of \$6,000 annually since 1971.

Taking into account inflationary factors over the years, your Committee would recommend a grant of \$7,000 be awarded to the Vancouver Symphony Society in 1986.
