ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: A work order is issued annually for unspecified roadworks, including chipwalks, retaining walls, and ditch elimination at various locations. Funds are provided in the 1987 - 1991 Capital Budget under Special Roads, Code 09.

60 21 067 Replace Watermains, Douglas Road, Roy Street to Manor Street.
CHARGE: 1987 - 1991 Capital Budget \$100,000
Code 21 - Mains, Pumping Stations, etc.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This work order is required to renew the Douglas Road watermain which recently experienced a major leak where it crosses under Highway 1. This is a secondary supply main to a large part of Burnaby's Central Valley. It will play an important role in the future as the primary feed for the Willingdon and Canada Way area when the primary main in that area is renewed later this year. Funds are provided in the 1987 - 1991 Capital Budget.
