R E P O R T

Appearing on the Agenda for the 1987 August 24 Council meeting was a letter from Mrs. J. D. Reid, 108 S. Boundary Road. Mrs. Reid expresses concern regarding the runoff from an aviary located at 3755 Pandora Street.

Engineering staff contacted Mr. Zanotto, the owner of 3755 Pandora, and undertook an investigation of the aviary. There exists a small drain to direct rainfall and runoff from the aviary to the lane. It is this runoff, that flows west along the lane to a catchbasin just east of Boundary Road, which Mrs. Reid makes reference to in her letter.

At the time of investigation Mr. Zanotto had only one bird in the aviary and stated he only has had a maximum of six budgies at any one time. He also stated that the bird droppings were collected and disposed of and were not washed out into the lane.

Environmental Health has been contacted and will undertake testing of the runoff from the aviary. Should the runoff pose a health problem, they will take the appropriate action.

Mr. Zanotto has been apprised of the contents of this report. Mrs. Reid is on holidays and staff have been unable to contact her.
