
R E P O R T

A survey and review report dated 1987 January and entitled "Municipal Development Controls and Procedures in Greater Vancouver" has been prepared by Donald W. Barcham and Michael Geller and Associates on behalf of the Greater Vancouver Regional District, Development Services Department. Copies of this lengthy report are being made available to all Council Members and a copy of this report will also be available at the Planning information counter for view by interested members of the public. A copy of notes summarizing a workshop held on 1987 March 24 regarding development procedures and controls, sponsored by the GVRD Technical Advisory Committee, and attended by municipal and provincial staff representatives and development industry representatives, is also provided with the report.

The subject material was considered by the GVRD Manager's Committee on 1987 June 10. Upon the recommendation of that Committee, the Policy Coordinating Committee of Mayors resolved at its 1987 July 22 meeting to forward the material to municipal councils for their information.

Burnaby staff have cooperated with the consultants retained by the GVRD Development Services Department in responding to the survey questionnaire which is the basis of the report and have participated in the workshop sponsored by the GVRD Technical Advisory Committee. The report is considered informative and constructive, and further coordinative discussions are intended to be pursued by the GVRD Technical Advisory Committee.
